

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Do you have to have a credit card to punt online?**
No, it is not necessary to have a credit or debit card to bet online.
- **Can people in South Australia put money into their Australian Post outlet instead of using their credit card online?**
Yes you can but you must have a TAB account first. Visit this site - <https://www.tab.com.au/Login/Registration/RegisterCustomerStep1.aspx?State=1> and fill out the online form. Once this is done, you can head down to your Australia Post outlet with ID and they can deposit and withdraw money from their TAB account. You cannot deposit cheques into your TAB Account at Australia Post
- **Are there alternatives to registering in the National league of the AFL Tipping Competition?**
Yes, TAB Sportsbet have set up a league for readers and punters called Amateur Footy SA. When you or your mates register, one of the form fields says "Private Leagues." Enter "477099" (without quotes) into the box to enter the Amateur Footy SA competition. It is still worth entering into the national competition as there are weekly prizes of two Grand Final tickets.
- **How do I contact the Call Centre?**
The Call Centre's number is 133 390. They have been advised that South Australian customers are entering the competition.
